


DUNCAN RACING REED PEDAL INSTALLATION for STOCK REED CAGES

- 1. Remove the reed cage assembly from the cylinder.
- 2. Remove the existing reed pedals from the reed cage.
- 3. Place the replacement reed pedals on the cage, position the rev-strip on top of the pedals, followed by the stock reed stops.
- 4. Center the reeds on the cage, install and tighten the mounting screws.
- 5. Install the reed cage back into the cylinder using new intake manifold gaskets. Torque to 8-10 ft. lbs. in a criss cross pattern by graduations of 5 ft. lbs.



*Caution: Do not install these reeds without stock reed stops. Without them, premature wear and eventually a fractured reed petal may result. Petals should be replaced every 6-10 hours of operation. **Should you have any problems or questions please call Duncan Racing.
